Duration: Up to 2.5 years or till end of project, subject to the performance of the fellow.

Qualifications: Post-graduate degree in Zoology/Wildlife Biology/Ecology/Forestry/Environmental Science with minimum 55% marks and NET qualification. In case NET qualified candidates are not available, non-NET candidates may be appointed as Junior Project Fellows. Age, reservation and other service conditions are as per the guidelines and rules of MoEF & CC and JNTBGRI.

Desirable: Experience in ecological research and good physique to conduct continuous fieldwork in difficult terrains of tropical forests for weeks together. Candidates with strong research aptitude will be encouraged for Ph.D. registration.
